

Response: Please refer to the Solicitation, Section 2. As given in the RFQ, DMPED anticipates the need for 5-10 title reports per year. Depending on agency activity, some years may require more/less title reports. DMPED is more actively engaged in the disposition of District land for the purpose of greater economic development and does not generally acquire properties. Over the past year, very few properties have been acquired and most of these properties have been for special projects. Thus, DMPED cannot predict an average purchase price of properties as this will fluctuate on the size of the deal and is dependent on timing of the market.
