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25) *Amendment 2 (Question 13 and its response) makes clear that temporary relocation sites included in the proposal must be acceptable to FEMS in order to be included in the proposal. We have a couple sites that we think are viable options. Who is the proper contact at FEMS or DGS to review the suitability of these sites?*

Prospective Respondents should not contact FEMS or DGS regarding proposed sites (or for any other reason related to the RFP) before the RFP Proposal Submission Due Date. DMPED will arrange coordination and review with FEMS and DGS at the appropriate time (after the RFP Proposal Submission Due Date). Prospective Respondents are advised to demonstrate how any proposed temporary relocation sites meet the requirements of the RFP including its amendments.

26) *If a respondent does not have a relocation site under full control (as defined in Amendment 2), does this mean we must include an option to develop the site in phases with the firestation remaining in operation in order to be deemed responsive?*
