








Yielded **6,700+** affordable housing units serving **16,800+** DC residents









DC Development Highlights



- Retail: 1.5 million sq ft under construction, 800K sq ft to deliver in 2017
- Residential: DC will deliver more than 8,200 residential units in 2017 (85% rental units)
- Hotel: DC to increase hotel room supply by 2.7% in 2017 and 3.0% in 2018.
- Development Starts: Could see 18 million sq ft of new projects starting in the near term












East Potomac Map






