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<u>Question #15:</u> Section H.9 requires submission of a subcontracting plan for contracts in excess of \$250,000. Since it is unknown at this point how much will be paid for services under this IDIQ contract, how is the threshold of \$250,000 to be interpreted? Since the term of the contract is one year, with options of the District to renew for subsequent one year periods, is the \$250,000 an annual threshold?
