R4 – Offerors shall include resumes for key personnel as attachments to their technical proposal.

Q11 – Regarding Task 6 - Land Use Vision and Urban Design Opportunities Report. **Q: Can you elaborate on your goals and expectations regarding the economic development strategy?**

R11 – The study area includes a variety of institutions that are economic anchors. The institutions in, and adjacent to the study area include universities and other educational facilities, medical facilities, religious institutions and more. As the land use vision and urban design opportunities are developed, how might we build on the institutions' contributions, and what are the opportunities for economic impact?

Q12 – Regarding C.5.5.1.3 The Contractor shall provide narration and edit the collected oral histories into a podcast series of three to four 30- to 40-minute episodes that meaningfully acknowledges the histories, injustice, innovations, and victories of participants' experiences in the area, in addition to highlighting the participants' vision of the area's future. **Q. Where will these podcasts be made available to the public? Does OP or a partner have an existing podcast program?**

R12 – The podcasts will be made available to the public. There is no existing OP podcast program. OP will be responsible for the distribution and hosting of the podcast.

Q13 – The RFP mentions respondents needing to be familiar with the demographics of the area, but it doesn't specify a demographic analysis task, rather refers to existing plans/studies. Do you know of any existing studies/plans that would have an up-to-date assessment of the demographics for the study area? Would that be the Rock Creek East Area Element? I'm just trying to determine if this is something to include in our scope, or if I can rely on something existing.

R13 – An up-to-date assessment of the demographics for the study area itself has not been completed. The maps in the RFP show the boundaries of the Comp Plan Area Elements as well as census tracts that overlap or connect with the North Capitol Vision study area since the study area doesn't fit neatly within one Area Element geography.

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
