The design for the complete renovation and modernization of the landmarked Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Library is currently underway. Bid opportunities for construction trades are anticipated in Summer and Fall 2016.

Total bid opportunities for construction trades are estimated to be greater than \$100 million for the following: Surveying, Line and Grade; Electrical Demolition and Temporary Electrical; Glass & Glazing; Structural Demolition; General Demolition/Hazmat Abatement and Removal; Lead Abatement and Restoration of Existing Steel Curtain Wall Framing; Construction Fence and Barricades; Site Demolition, Earthwork and Site Utilities; Site Paving (asphalt and concrete, retaining walls); Landscaping and Site; Structural Steel and Miscellaneous Metal Fabrication; Cast In Place Concrete; Masonry; Stone Restoration; Rough and Finish Carpentry; Roofing, Metal Panels, Waterproofing including Green Roof; Fireproofing; Doors, Frames, Hardware; Interior Glass and Glazing; Skylights; Caulking and Sealants; Plaster, Drywall and Acoustical Systems; Flooring including Terrazzo, Tile, Carpet, Resilient, Wood; Paint and Coatings; Specialties including Signage, Lockers; Toilet Accessories and Partitions; Food Service and Residential Appliances; Furniture, Fixtures, Equipment; Theater Fixed Seating; Theater Equipment; Conveying; Plumbing and HVAC; Fire Protection; Electrical including Audio Visual, Security, Telecommunications/ Data: and Fire Alarm.

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
