DPR is currently working with Moody Nolan Architecture on the design for a new recreation center and other site improvements, including: new splash pad, multipurpose athletic field, fitness trail with outdoor fitness equipment, renovated tennis and basketball courts, new playground equipment, outdoor lighting, amphitheater seating, community garden area, fencing, erosion control management, urban forest renewal, landscaping and other improvements based on the outcome on ongoing community meetings. The project will also include the demolition of the existing outdated 2,000 SF recreation facility.

Current proposed improvements with regard to the new recreation center include the following enhancements: multiple multi-purpose rooms with divisible partitions, senior lounge, teen lounge, demonstration kitchen, generous lobby space with reception area, computer room/classroom, fitness area, staff offices, reading room, wireless internet service and DPR's first outdoor accessible urban farm. The new recreation facility with also serve as a community emergency shelter with a natural gas powered generator.

DPR will be working with Moody Nolan Architecture to finalize the building and site design by the end of Summer 2016. General Contractor bidding is expected to occur in September 2016, with an anticipated construction period beginning Fall / Winter 2016 and lasting through Winter 2017.
