DPR (Department of Parks and Recreation) is currently working with Studio 27 Architecture on finalizing the design for our first Net Zero Energy "NZE" facility. The scope of work will be to raze the existing field house and replace it with a facility that includes: rainwater harvesting system, solar roof panels, thermal wall systems, LED lighting, a self-learning Wi-Fi enabled thermostat system, high recycled content finishes and other innovative components of high-level sustainability.

The current design includes: a demonstration and teaching kitchen, community rooms, computer lab, offices, restrooms and programmable spaces for community interaction and education. Once completed, the center will serve as working model of environmental sustainability to the community and host a variety of urban nature programming.

Design is nearing completion and anticipated solicitation to obtain a General Contractor will take place in June 2017.
