

<p><b>Question #1:</b> During the pre-proposal meeting, Ms. Pulugurta mentioned that this proposal only applies to DCRA and no other agencies. The RFP specifically mentions several other agencies. RFP Sections C.5.1.1, C.6.1.1, C.6.1.2, C.6.1.7.4.2, C.6.2.3.4, C.6.3.1 and C.6.3.3.8 have requirements for inclusion of other agencies. Please explain and confirm if the proposal should include the required efforts stated in these sections or not.</p> <p><b>Response:</b> Ms. Pulugurta mentioned that the RFP applies to DCRA systems only and all integration with other agencies is strictly limited to publicly available information and no integration with back-office programs is expected. DCRA may choose to provide access to other agencies once the system is in production. Responses must address all requirements identified in the RFP.</p>

<p><b>Response:</b> DCRA is open to options and proposals should include details of how the proposed options would be structured and staffed, including percentage of onsite presence, if any.</p>			
<p><b>Question #5:</b> Do the Operations, Maintenance, and Support as described in Section C.6.5.6 of RFP have to be performed onsite at DCRA or can they be done offsite?</p>			
<p><b>Response:</b> Same response as to Question #4 above.</p>			
<p><b>Question #6:</b> RFP Section C.5.3.1, technical requirement TR-2.0 states that data migration scripts are needed for several retiring legacy systems. Please list and describe the retiring legacy systems and confirm that the new system is replacing these legacy systems.</p>			
<p><b>Response:</b> Please refer to Section C.6.3.2.7 of the RFP.</p>			
<p><b>Question #7:</b> RFP Section C.6.5.2.3 requires delivery of source code. Please confirm that this requirement does not extend to any licensed software (e.g. Microsoft Dynamics CRM) that is needed as part of the solution.</p>			
<p><b>Response:</b> Confirmed.</p>
