

Question #1: On the First Source Agreement – it asks what is the contract number, award amount, when it would begin/end. I do not have that information and I reviewed the solicitation and I did not see it listed?					
Response: The contract number, award amount, and the contract start and end dates are provided by this office and not by the offeror.

Question #2: Would you like applicants to submit a separate price proposal for financial piece or just fill in the boxes that were provided in section B?

Response: Offerors shall submit price information as stated in Section B. Price proposals shall be bound separately from the technical proposal. See Section L.4 Price Proposal for further instruction.

Question #3: In section J, are applicants required to turn in each of the 11 attachments? Some of the attachments have no place for signature or any writing required and it appears that they are there for informational purposes, but in the solicitation it reads as if we are to turn those in? Please clarify which of the attachments need to be turned in.

Response: Offerors shall complete and submit with its offer Attachments J.3., J.4 (if applicable), J.7, J.8, J.9 (if applicable), J.10 and J.11. See Section L.3.5 Section 5 – Attachments for further instruction.

Question #4: Is this a new project – meaning is this the first time this has been placed out to bid? Or has this solicitation been required to go out for re-bid by District standards.

Response: This is a new requirement, and the first time out for bid.

Question #5: How many events does NCI plan to hold on an annual basis? Are the events to be geared towards each individual project or just for the initiative itself?

Response: The number of annual events will depend on the communication strategy that is developed with the contractor, but we anticipate at least one but no more than two. We envision both; events that are geared towards the individual neighborhood and events for the overall initiative.

Question #6: NCI has suggested creating a newsletter and brochure; are these documents geared towards the initiative or for each redevelopment project?

Response: NCI envisions a newsletter and brochure for the initiative.

Question #7: Is there a ceiling for costs per year for these items.

Response: Offerors must propose the ceiling cost for each reimbursable item listed in Section B – Price Schedule.

Question #8: The offeror would like to include residents that may have an interest in marketing or getting children involved in a posted contest or putting together the newsletter. Is this okay or should these documents be geared just towards the redevelopment of the four projects?

Response: The District does not understand this question, however offerors may propose whatever it wants.

Question #9: When will DMPED award this contract; what timeframe is your office working from in order get this started?

Response: The District would like to make award during the month of June 2014.

Question #10: It seems the District is looking for additional developers local as well as national developers. The offeror is under the impression that all of these developments have developers attached to them already. Is this an effort to get additional subcontractors or is the District looking to replace any of the lead developers?

Response: Of the four neighborhoods, only Barry Farm has a selected master developer. Park Morton is in the process of procuring a developer. The other two neighborhoods do not have a developer.
