Great Streets & DC Locally Made Manufacturing Grant Purpose

- <u>Transform</u> designated emerging commercial corridors into thriving, walkable, shoppable and inviting neighborhood experiences
- Incentivize the development of <u>single-tenant buildings</u> that can accommodate small manufacturing or a <u>multi-tenant building</u> that can provide spaces for <u>manufacturers</u>, <u>post-incubator</u> and/or <u>emerging growth</u> <u>companies</u> engaged in consumer goods and/or some durable good production.



FY23 Locally Made Manufacturing Grant Funding

- DMPED will award up \$600,000.00 total in grants to be disbursed to successful applicants of the Grant.
- Maximum request per application is up to \$200,000.00.





Getting Locally Made Manufacturing Grant Ready Checklist

- ☐ Have a business that is located within or along the border of a Great Street corridor
- Evidence of site control through:
 - Ownership by deed or mortgage
 - Executed contract of sale of option to purchase
 - Lease with the property owner with a minimum unexpired term of at least five (5) years (from date of application) Applicants who lease their business property are required to submit a <u>notarized affidavit from their landlord</u> authorizing the proposed improvement project.
 - Notarized LOI is <u>accepted</u> during the application period. *If selected for a conditional award, the business will need* <u>one of the required documents</u> *listed to show evidence of site control.*
- Be in Good Standing with the DC Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection (DLCP), the DC Office of Tax and Revenue (OTR), the DC Department of Employment Services (DOES), and the federal Internal Revenue Service (IRS)
- Have an active Basic Business License
- Have financial records readily available
- Possess proof of property and liability insurance





Initial Screening Review Common Errors

- Licenses and/or registrations are inactive
- Business legal name is not used on all official documents. DBA is not accepted
- Tax Issues- Business did not file Business Franchise Tax Return.
- Business owes money to the government ex- nonpayment of child support, fines, unfiled tax returns from previous years.
- Business is not located on a Great Streets Corridor. Business project address must be on a Great Street. LOI and/or Deed/Lease must match requested project location.
- New business 1 yr. or less did not submit Personal Tax returns when Business tax returns are not available
- Business tax extension accepted only for 2022. All previous years must be filed.
- Business previously received funding for same location.





Use of Funds

Eligible

- Exterior and/or interior improvements
- Purchase of furniture, fixtures, and equipment

Ineligible Funding Uses

- Debts
- Expenses associated with preparing this application
- Inventory
- Legal fees
- Marketing
- Payroll
- Rent
- All expenses not listed above as eligible uses of funds.





Who is Ineligible?

- Adult entertainment
- Bar, Tavern or Nightclub*
- Cyber or online only
- Financial services
- Hotel
- Liquor store
- Phone store
- Professional services
- Seasonal (partial year)
- Construction/general contracting/architecture/design-build
- Previously awarded businesses that are expanding existing operations and/or relocating to another location are not eligible.
- Businesses which have received a total of \$150,000 or more of funding from the Great Streets or H
 Street Grants Programs are not eligible.

Please note that the type of businesses ineligible are those holding an ABRA License that do not require a food minimum.(ex: Tavern, Bar, or Nightclub)
